

Garners Field Archery Operating Procedure

The Archery Range must be booked in advanced via the campsite booking form

Users MUST complete the Archery Range logbook that can be found in the Archery Store.

Garners Field Range is an *Archery GB Have A Go Range* there is a STRICT maximum bow draw weight of 18lbs (8.15kg)

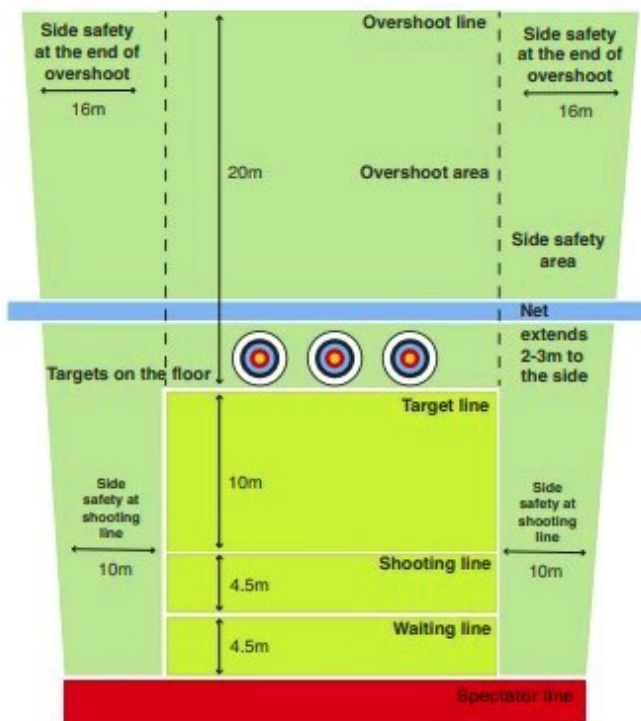
The Archery Range must be operated by Qualified Person at all times.

Please refer to the Farnham District Scouts Risk Assessment for Archery and ensure you have your own activity risk assessment.

Range Layout:

A Have a Go Range

- Targets must be on the ground
- A net can be used to reduce the overshoot required from 45 metres to 20 metres
- Recommended maximum draw weight of 18lbs



Target bosses are to be placed 1m from the backstop curtain which must be drawn loosely across.

Maximum 4 bosses placed 1m apart and each be supported in the ground with a single road pin facing away from the shooting line

Archers to stand with one foot either side of the shooting line.

Please contact wardens for access to the archery store where all equipment, ropes to mark shooting/waiting line and signage can be found here. If using Garners Field equipment please treat it with respect and ensure it is returned clean and dry. (target bosses can be return wet) Bosses must not be carried by the straps!

If you are not using our supplied Bosses only soft bosses are allowed no straw ones.



Archery in progress signs can be found in the store, one must be placed in each of the locations marked in red in the diagram below, Spare signs can be placed at the Range Officers discretion



- 1, Main entrance side
- 2, On the outside of the fence
- 3, On the north side
- 4, Across the river path, please make sure the rope is across to close off the pathway
- 5 On the outside of the Entrance to the sluice viewing platform.

Garners Field Wardens reserve the right to stop the activity if they any unsafe practices have been observed.

If the ground is dry a single vehicle may be parked inside the range to the left of the entrance for the safe storage of bows and arrows during breaks in the activity and for spare equipment.

Outdoor tables are available on site if needed, a gazebo or similar can be used both in the waiting area and to cover the shooting line but please follow all Archery GB safety rules.

The Range Officers must be able to see all areas of the range at all times.

At the End of each session please check all Arrows have been picked up.

Return all borrowed equipment to the store after your sessions.
